DEFINITION:

To perform a variety of work related to city right of ways, streets, sewers, parks

The following are typical illustrations of duties encompassed by the job, not an all-inclusive or limiting list:

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

\* Cutting grass, weeds safely and effectively applying herbicide; washing, waxing city vehicles; oil changes and service various equipment; drive light trucks, dump truck, street sweeper, mowers, operate other construction equipment safely and effectively. Use a wide variety of hand and power tools, assist staff with repair and or replacement of sewer mains, storm mains and service connections.

OTHER JOB FUNCTIONS:

\*Install maintain and replace street signs; apply cold patch- hot mix in repair of potholes; perform carpentry work on pump stations and various city buildings; work in city parks as needed; take standby duty.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates should have knowledge of basic methods, tools, materials, and equipment used in maintenance of the city infrastructure related work, replace repair sewer and storm pipe and service equipment used in maintenance of sewer, storm, and streets work. Understand and carry out both oral and written directions, Establish and maintain effective work relationships with those contacted in the course of work, ability to perform heavy manual labor lift pull and or drag up to 50LBS, work outdoors in all weather conditions, valid Oregon driver's license with satisfactory driving record, class B CDL and flagger certified within 180 days from date of hire, at least 18 years of age, must pass pre-employment drug screening and back ground check. Ability to respond within 30 minutes to public works for after hour calls or an emergency.
