III. Committee Reports

1. Community development- Thomas McIntosh was not present, but Steve Johnson of the Planning Commission reported that the City will be adopting the Traffic Safety Plan (TSP) and the Housing Needs Analysis tonight. The round about at Brockway was discussed and still is on the ODOT step. Lookingglass Estates next phase will be impacted by the flood plain issues and the requirements and engineer study.

2. Katie Starkle reported we are moving forward with the Oktoberfest and the Wine Walk Events with 5k in raffle prizes for the wine walk which will be July 1 from 3-7. We have sold \$1000 in raffle tickets. There will be fireworks that night for the 4th of July Celebration. Flyers are available. Oktoberfest will be September 23 and 24th at the Riverbend Park. We will change the funding so that participants will sign up that day and pay \$15.00 per game. We will have Bingo, kids area, 4 breweries, 3 bands. Need 1 more sponsorship.

IV. OLD BUSINESS

ODOT will be paving from the intersection with 42 down 99 to the Round Prairie exit 113. This will be from May 8th to June 30th.

RV Park was approved with 34 conditions. They will have 13 cabins(tiny houses).
