The TSP draft and housing needs analysis are going before the city council on the 19th to adopt..It includes deficiencies in the City, strategies, and funding sources. Budget approvals are being worked on. Granting opportunities are more likely once the analysis is complete. Thomas is now the assistant city manager. Andy How is the public works director. The county is doing paving on 99 to Dole road. Sewer lines are being looked at due to problems. City may need a bond levy. The Route to Schools paving project is still looking for funding, a 2 million dollar matching grant is available. The facade grants have 408k available. Valley drug received 60k to complete their parking lot.

2. We are moving forward with the Oktoberfest and the Wine Walk Events with 5k in raffle prizes for the wine walk which will be July 1 from 3-7. Oktoberfest will be September 23 and 24th at the Riverbend

Park. We will change the funding so that participants will sign up that day and pay \$15.00 per game. We will have Bingo, kids area, 4 breweries, 3 bands. We have all sponsorships filled.
