

# Tournament Event Individual Game Rules:

Pretzel Eating – 1 ½ cups dry pretzel with 2 oz water.

- 1.) Individuals must have both hands on table until horn sounds that heat has started.
- 2.) Individual must keep their entire body inside their designated competition area.
- 3.) Each competitor must consume their own pretzels.
- 4.) This is a timed competition. The individual with the fastest overall time consuming the entire content of their pretzel bowl and glass of water will win \$250 and qualify to move on to the final to compete for the \$2,500 cash prize.

Stein Hold.

1. This is a timed competition with the individual holding the longest overall hold time in the entire competition winning \$250 and qualifying to move on to the final to compete for the \$2,500 cash prize.
2. At the sound of the horn to start the heat all individuals must hold their stein straight out in front of them.
3. Arms must be straight with no bend.
4. Any lowering of the arm or bending of the elbow will eliminate the competitor.
5. Thumb must be wrapped around the handle making a fist.

Keg Race.

- 1.) This is a timed competition with the fastest time in the entire competition winning \$250 and a qualifying spot in the final to compete for the \$2,500.
- 2.) On go competitors will roll their keg down and past the 15 yard mark then turn around and roll their keg back across the start/finish line.
- 3.) The keg must cross both the start/finish line & the 15 yard mark.
- 4.) Competitors must stay in their designated lanes.

Stein Race.

- 1.) This is a timed competition with the fastest time in the entire competition winning \$250 and a qualifying spot in the finals to compete for the \$2,500.
- 2.) Individuals must start behind the water bucket. On Go they will use 2 small stein glasses to run back and forth between the bucket of water and growler. Growlers are marked with a fill line. The individual that is able to fill their growler to the designated line the fastest is the winner.
- 3.) Teams must stay in their designated lanes.

#### Bucket Ball.

- 1.) This is a timed competition with the fastest time of the entire competition winning \$250 and a spot in the finals to compete for the \$2,500.
- 2.) Each competitor will have 5 buckets to clear.
- 3.) Each team member must throw their ball from behind the 10 foot mark.
- 4.) After all balls have been thrown the individual can run to their buckets- remove the buckets with balls in them and retrieve their missed balls, run back behind the throw line and continue until they have cleared all their buckets.
- 5.) Do not throw the buckets
- 6.) All buckets must be cleared in less than 5 minutes.
- 7.) The individual with the fastest time clearing all 5 buckets will win \$250 and a spot in the finals competing for the \$2,500.

#### Hammerslagen.

- 1.) The individual with the least # of hits to flush their nail into the log will win \$250 and a spot in the finals to compete for the \$2,500.
- 2.) Each nail will be started.
- 3.) When instructed by the referee to Hammerslagen each individual will swing their hammer using the triangular end to hit the nail.
- 4.) This will continue until a nail is flush into the log.
- 5.) In the event of a tie at the end of the tournament the individual that can hammer in 6 nails the fastest will qualify their team for the final.

# **Sunday at NOON 6 QUALIFYING FINALIST COMPETE IN RIVER BEND PARK for \$2,500:**

## **OKTOBERFEST RELAY**

- Competitors will eat 1 cup of dried pretzels and 2 oz of water
- After finishing pretzels they will run to the nail pounding station to hammer in 3 pre-started nails.
- When nails are flush they will run to the keg rolling station and roll the keg 10 yards down to the bucket ball station.
- The individual will clear all 5 buckets by tossing tennis balls into them.
- After all 5 bucket have been cleared the will be at the stein race leg and run back and forth between a bucket of water and growler until they reach the fill line.
- Once reaching the designated fill line competitors will run back to the Keg and roll it back across the keg starting line.
- The individual will then run to the pretzel eating station and finish 1 cup of dried pretzels and water.

The individual with the fastest time for the relay will win \$2,500.

In the event of a tie, the tie breaker will be the stein hold.

If an individual wins multiple qualifying events they will have the option to complete the relay for each win if they do not hold the best score.

A substitute competitor will only be allowed if the winning proceeds are being donated to a verified Non-Profit. The competitor will forfeit the cash prize with a check written directly to the designated 501C3.
